## 2021 Parkinson's Virtual Choir Concert Parkinson Voice Project

*Watch over 300 people with Parkinson's and their family and friends

Richardson, Texas — Parkinson Voice Project, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, is hosting their second annual Parkinson's Virtual Choir Concert on November 6<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm (CT). The show will feature over **300** people with Parkinson's and their family and friends performing "Sweet Caroline" and two original songs titled "We Find Our Voice" and "Intent." The show will also include a virtual tour of Parkinson Voice Project's one-of-a-kind speech therapy clinic. You can watch the show for free on the organization's website!

Since 2006, Parkinson Voice Project has hosted an annual concert called "SING OUT!" where people with Parkinson's show off their voices which have been restored through speech therapy. Due to the pandemic, this concert went "virtual" in 2020. Hosting an online performance has allowed Parkinson Voice Project to include singers from all over the United States, as well as Australia, Canada, Nigeria, the Philippines, Trinidad and Tobago, and the United Kingdom.



More than 6,000 people viewed last year's Virtual Choir Concert from multiple countries, including Australia, Canada, Finland, India, Ireland, Israel, Malaysia, Puerto Rico, South Africa, Switzerland, the United Kingdom, and the United States. This year's reach is sure to expand further across the globe.
